

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC RULE-MAKING HEARING  
NEBRASKA REAL PROPERTY APPRAISER BOARD**

Notice is hereby given that the Nebraska Real Property Appraiser Board will hold a rule-making hearing on Monday, September 26, 2011, at 8:00 a.m. in the Nebraska Real Property Appraiser Board Office, Lower Level, Nebraska State Office Building, 301 Centennial Mall South, Lincoln, Nebraska.

The hearing will be held on the question of amending sections of Nebraska Administrative Code Title 298 of the Real Property Appraiser Board. The proposed changes will incorporate the statutory regulation and oversight of Appraisal Management Companies conducting business in Nebraska by the addition of Chapter 10; changes to Chapter 9 implementing the proposed adoption of NAC 297, Chapter 4, Rules and Practice and Procedure for Hearings in Contested Cases Before an Agency in regard to appraiser disciplinary procedures for hearing; changing the language in reference to enforcement and grievance; addition of Chapter 11 to establish the Appraisal Management Company procedures for investigations and disciplinary proceedings; a definition added to Chapter 1; and minimal editing changes. No fiscal impact is anticipated for any state agency, political subdivision or regulated person other than the NRPAB.

All interested persons are invited to attend and testify at the hearing. Written comments may also be submitted prior to the hearing and will be made part of the record at the time of the hearing provided the comments are received by Tuesday, September 20, 2011.
